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modernity presents itself as an age of increasing social disintegration secularization and rationalization urbanization and globalization individualization and digitalization make it difficult for communities today modernity comes with desirable promises that make it attractive but it does not come free its price is escalating modern loneliness denis newiak tells a cultural history of modernization that from industrialization to the late modern network society produces ever new and harsher experiences of loneliness

and global contexts the final section explores the pragmatic justification of human rights how do we motivate the recognition and enforcement of human rights in the real world this topical book should be of interest to a range of academics from disciplines spanning law philosophy religion and politics

recent events in the psychology of aging documents the successful integration of aging into the mainstream of psychology leading psychologists present overviews of the key issues and research findings on mainstream topics these include cognitive neuroscience visual attention learning memory and cognition as well as personality and happiness the intersection of aging content with mainstream psychology is also prominent in the areas of emotions personality and social psychology as seen in the chapters on subjective well being emotional development self esteem and personality trajectories the seven chapters of this book offer information on such topics as the seven sins of memory categorizing the common breakdowns of memory in everyday life and the special breakdown of sins that increase with aging problems with attention and learning and offers answers to questions such as do emotions get blunted with age do older people focus more on positive feelings and the age old question of whether older people are happier than younger people is given in the chapter on the evolving concept of subjective well being and the multifaceted nature of happiness questions about what occurs to one's self esteem and personality are also masterfully discussed and the answers may be surprising the concluding seventh chapter provides a cultural lens on the biopsychosocial study of aging

smoking diet stress coping and exercise among other behaviors and psychological states are now clearly implicated in the development of cardiovascular diseases prevention based largely on altering behaviors that contribute to this chronic disease is now as important a goal as is treatment of those already afflicted this volume based on a recent meeting of the academy of behavioral medicine research addresses several important areas of research in the general area of cardiovascular disease the topics covered reflect on important aspects of this phenomenon such as the long term development of coronary artery disease central nervous system cns regulation of blood pressure heart rate and sympathetic tone playing a pivotal role in sympathetic activity and hypertension learned blood pressure modulation and baroreceptor activation as a means of reducing the aversiveness of stress or noxious stimulation and the notion that symptoms of heart disease or infarction may occur in the absence of organic heart disease having been impressed by the recent advances in the field the editors of this book capture the wealth of newly acquired knowledge about behavioral factors in cardiovascular disease and how the body's nervous endocrine and cardiovascular systems work together
